Mr Gregory reported that he was having trouble getting parts for the brass ball cocks. He suggested trialling Henson gate valves and ball cocks as these were guaranteed not to stick and were also frost proof. Another advantage was they could be used under low and high pressure.

Mr Hammond and Mr L Bird to organise a working bee around April 2011. They would advise all members a month in advance. There would be a need to go around all taps and look at Makapou.

Mr Platts advised that he would get a digger in to clear the log jam above the intake.
