Council did adopt recommendation 11/BCC/003 (to seek assistance through the Regional Land Transport Committee to review the earlier decision (c.2006) regarding pedestrian safety on Bridge Street in Bulls). Decisions on crossings are part of the role of NZ Land Transport not the Regional Land Transport Committee and NZLT have been involved with the plan change for the New World supermarket. As part of this plan change a kea crossing has been approved but the exact location has yet to be decided.
